



H4H Housing Assistance Fund Information

The Housing Assistance Fund (HAF), managed by Santa Cruz County's Housing for Health Division (H4H) in partnership with the Community Action Board of Santa Cruz County (CAB), was created to provide a flexible source of funding to help Santa Cruz County eligible participants and their families obtain and maintain long-term stable housing. HAF applications are prepared and submitted on behalf of participants by eligible providers that work for H4H partner agencies. HAF assistance is limited and short-term.

Approvals for the Housing Assistance Fund will be based on eligibility and funding available. The provider submitting a HAF application on your behalf will inform you if their application has been approved by H4H.

By accepting this assistance, you are agreeing to receive follow up calls from CAB. The purpose of these calls is to assess whether the HAF program helped you obtain or maintain your housing. CAB staff will call you every three months after you receive this assistance. They will stop calling after six months have elapsed since the last time you accessed Housing Assistance Funds.
